



A **football field** is a rectangular area of artificial surface (50 mm Grass) where football is played. It's marked with lines called boundary lines.

Dimensions

- The longer sides are called touchlines, and the shorter sides are called goal lines
- The field is divided into two halves by a halfway line
- The center mark is at the midpoint of the halfway line
- The lines on the ground are equally wide, not to exceed 12 centimeters (5 inches)
- The corners of the pitch are marked by corner flags

Field size

- The Length can be any size as per the area available in rectangular size.

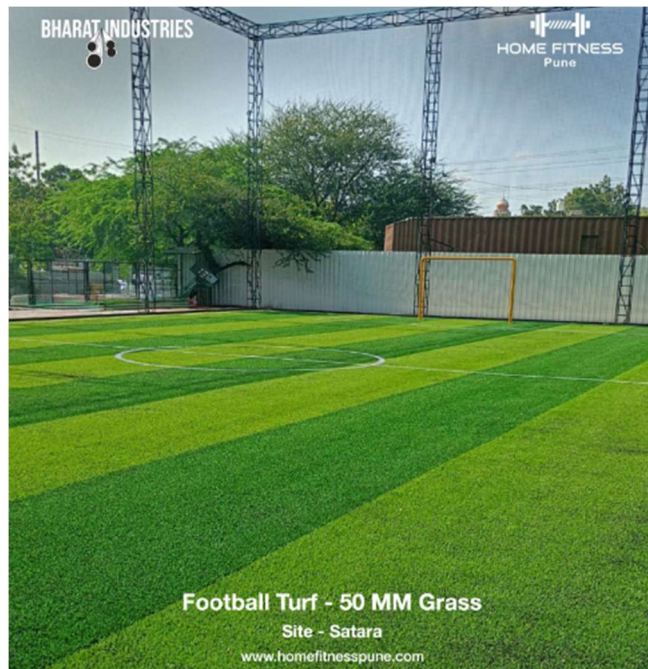
Field markings

- The field is marked with continuous lines which must not be dangerous
- Artificial playing surface material may be used for the field markings on natural fields if it is not dangerous

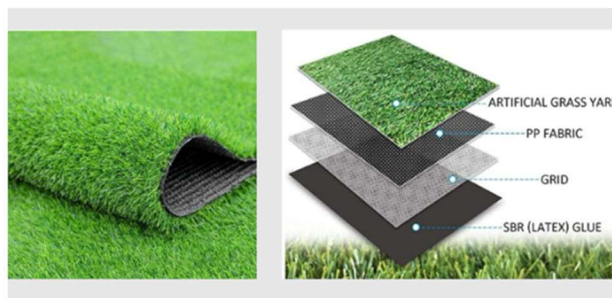
A football game is played between two teams of 11 players each. A team scores Goals by moving a ball across the other team's goal line. The team that scores more goals wins.

A Typical Football Turf needs

- A concrete base layer of 4 Inch
- Base layer of 10 mm Sbr buffing – for cushioning
- 50 mm Fifa Approved Dual Color Grass, 10000 Dtex
- 15 mm Cricket Pitch
- Rubber Granules 500 grams in one square feet & Silicon Sand 2 Kg in one square feet
- Side Netting – 22 Feet High (2.5 mm thick)
- Top Netting – 1.5 mm thick (50 mm Hole Size)
