


A "paddle court," more accurately called a "padel court," is a dedicated sports area enclosed by walls, typically made of glass, where the game of padel is played; it's roughly half the size of a tennis court, measuring 20 meters long by 10 meters wide, and features a central net, allowing players to hit the ball off the walls during gameplay, making it a strategic and fast-paced sport with similar rules to tennis but with an underhand serve.

## Key points about a paddle court:

- **Dimensions:** 20 meters long by 10 meters wide
- Walls: Usually made of tempered glass on the back and side walls, with a mesh fence at the top
- Playing surface: Synthetic grass
- Net: Divides the court in half, with a slightly higher center than at the sides
- Gameplay: Players can hit the ball off the walls, adding a unique element to the game
- Serving: Underhand serve
