



A **pickleball court** is 20 ft wide by 44 ft long, and is the same size as a doubles badminton court. It's used for both singles and doubles play.

Features

- The net is 36 in high at the sidelines and 34 in high in the middle
- The court is striped like a tennis court
- There is a 7 ft non-volley zone in front of the net, known as the "kitchen"
- Pickleball courts can be built specifically for pickleball or converted from tennis or badminton courts

Pickleball is a paddle sport that combines elements of tennis, badminton, and ping pong. It's played with a plastic ball with holes and paddles. The game is suitable for players of all ages and skill levels.

Pickleball court rules

- No volleying in the kitchen
- There must be one bounce per side
- Serves must be made from the baseline
- Serves cannot land in the non-volley zone
- The game ends at 11, 15, or 21 points
